Wolsey Park Development update

Welcome to the latest development update for Wolsey Park where we provide information about progress onsite and let you know the next stages.

About Wolsey Park

Countryside's Wolsey Park phase 2 consists of 76 new homes and associated open space.

Phase 2 is Countryside's second phase of the wider development.

All homes on Phase 2 will be fitted with PV panels and benefit from an electric charging point as standard.

Construction Advancing Well

Works are progressing well on site with our second phase. The northern part of the phase is now complete with occupations taking place in December last year.

Construction works will continue throughout 2024 and progress down the spine road to the south of the site. It is anticipated that this phase will be complete in the spring of 2025.

Road Sweeping

Countryside's site team work to ensure that the spine road is kept clean from mud and dirt caused by construction vehicles and road sweeping operates weekly.

Contractor Parking

We understand that contractor parking has been a concern for residents in the past. Countryside's site team have been actively implementing a fining system for our sub-contractor parking if found to be parked on the spine road or residential road.

Streetlighting

We are aware that there are some faulty streetlights on Wolsey Park road and acknowledge residents' safety concerns. We are working alongside the asset owner to identify the fault and will be undertaking remedials works shortly to rectify this issue.

Timeline

- The first occupations on Countryside's second took place in October 2023 and will continue up until Spring 2025.
- The Show homes and marketing suite for Phase 2 remains at the north of Wolsey Park Road.
- In phase 2 there is a mixture of adopted and private roads. The roads to be adopted by Essex Highways will be adopted following completion of the phase.

Public Open Space

The Public Open Space located to the western boundary of phase two will be provided in line with construction progress on-site. We will be installing footpath connection links from the open space to the development which will provide residents with ease of access to the wider community. We will be able to provide further updates on anticipated completion dates in future correspondence.

Managing Agent

- The Land Trust took on the maintenance of Wolsey Park in April 2023. They are currently responsible for the
 northern end of the estate which includes the verges, swales and play areas as well as the meadow areas to
 the West.
- The landscape contractor at Wolsey Park is Plant Style Limited. They are responsible for routine maintenance such as grass cutting, hedge trimming, weeding, litter picking, emptying of litter and dog waste.
- Countryside will be responsible for the landscaped areas of the development until the handovers take place.

Upcoming Handovers

- We are due to handover the remaining areas of open space on our first phase to The Land Trust this Spring. This will include the areas of landscaping on Chancellor Street as well as the footpath between Andrewes Way and Gowlett Mews. Following this next handover, all areas of open space on our Phase 1 will be managed by the Land Trust.
- The first areas of landscaping installed on Phase 2 are currently being maintained Countryside's landscape contractor, MBM, who will maintain these areas for the first year prior to handover to the Land Trust.

Other updates

New Landscape Corridor

The landscape corridor to the eastern boundary of the wider development is anticipated to be completed throughout 2024 and 2025. Once this is completed it will provide a new social space for the community of Wolsey Park and provide another children's play area, a young space for teenagers, kickabout area and a community orchard and allotment.

Childrens Play Area

We are aware that during periods of high rainfall there is a flow of water from the children's play area onto Wolsey Park road. Investigative works have been carried out however further works are required to find the source. This will be taking place in the Springtime. We will provide further updates in future correspondence.

X30 Bus Service

Since October 2023, the X30, operated by First Bus has been running a service through Wolsey Park.

As a new occupier you are entitled to two free one-year travel passes to Rayleigh rail Station per household. You can apply for these passes within 12 months of moving into your home.

There are copies of the leaflet used to access your free travel located in the Sales and Marketing suite. You can also download the First Bus app for real time bus travel and

service updates.

Education Site

You will have recently received an update regarding the proposals for the education site at Wolsey Park. Alongside Countryside's financial contributions to education, part of the site has also been reserved for education facility should Essex County Council require it.

Essex County Council are currently consulting on the principal of a new SEND School to be provided alongside a new early year's facility which is due to conclude in April. If there are any specific matters you would like them to consider as part of this consultation we would recommend writing to Essex County Council as part of their current consultation.
