## Keeping you updated

We wanted to provide you with an update on the development and what you can expect from us over the coming months.

## Development Overview

Earl's Croft is a fantastic new development by Countryside Homes. It has been thoughtfully designed, offering a selection of 2,3 and 4 bedroom homes. We are combining family-friendly homes and green open spaces to create a thriving and sustainable community for the future.

### Summary of what's being built:

- 57 Open Market homes.
- In partnership with Places for People, we are proud to be delivering 83 quality homes to support affordable living.
- Creating a LEAP (local equipped area of play).
- Three new attenuation ponds for excess rainwater storage.
- Solar panels & EV car charger to every home.

## Site Activity

We are continuing to make great progress on the development!

Plastering and second fix stage are underway on our initial releases of homes. We are excited to be working towards our first handovers in May/June.

We are excited to be getting ready to open our show homes in mid April. Some final snagging are currently being completed as we prepare for the opening. Our on-site sales office is now open.

## Piling & Services

Vibro Piling is due to start end of May/June for the 2<sup>nd</sup> phase of the site.

Installation of gas, electric and fibre connections is underway on site.

## Timeline

- In September 2026, we opened our temporary sales office in Earl Shilton selling off plan, with our first release of new homes anticipated for completion in May/June 2026.
- In October 2026, we were excited to made a start on the scaffolding and we began the timber frame installation.
- We have now opened our on-site sales office, please book an appointment to see us.

## Ecology

- Over the course of the development, we will be planting over a hundred new trees, across the open spaces, streets, and front gardens of new homes. We have maintained the hedgerow where possible.
- We have preserved the existing wetland area and added 3 new attenuation ponds which will attract wildlife.
- Our landscaping will be bee friendly, and wildflower seed packets will be available in the on-site sale suite.
- We are incorporating a hedgehog highway to the fence line design to allow free movement and installing bird and bat boxes on selected dwellings.
