

Hepworth Place Development Update

Keeping you updated

We want to provide you with an update on the development and what you can expect from us over the coming months.

Overview

Hepworth Place is delivering 433 new homes (170 open market, 123 shared ownership and 140 affordable rent).

In addition, the development will provide:

- A new crèche to be operated by Kinderzimmer (ground floor of Greenway House).
- A new Civic Centre.
- Additional commercial unit (use TBC).
- High quality new public realm including landscaped gardens with over 200 new trees and play facilities on Chestnuts Field alongside an all-weather perimeter path.

Site Activity

- Tuffin Court, Dury Court, Honeycomb Court and Medway Court) are all now build complete.
- Bramble Apartments, Lotus Point and Wiffen Apartments are all now build complete.
- Greenway House, including the new crèche facility will reach build completion in June 2026.
- Construction of the new Civic Building is progressing; it is envisaged that build completion will take place in June 2026.
- Works on the west side of the site are expected to commence later this year.

District Heating

The development has a district heating network where heat is generated from an energy centre and air source heat pumps located in Block C. All homes are now connected to the main energy centre, following the removal of the temporary gas boilers. Vital Energi are the energy supplier, and they are responsible for the billing, operation and maintenance of the energy centre.

Sales & Marketing

1. The sales launch of the open market and shared ownership homes commenced in March 2024. The marketing suite and show home for the open market homes is located on the front lawns on the east of the site. Book your appointment today by calling 020 3432 5687.
2. The Queen Elizabeth II Commemorative Garden and Sensory Garden at the rear of the town hall have been open since 2024.
3. Construction works for the new Civic Building on the west of the site remain ongoing with a forecast completion date of 2026.
4. First build completions of the open market, shared ownership homes took place in August 2024, with the first affordable rented occupations having taken place in September 2024.

Enterprise Car Club

Following a change in operator, the development will benefit from an Enterprise Car Club, offering residents access to a shared vehicle on a pay-as-you-go basis. An exclusive membership and driving credit offer will be available. The target launch is July 2026, with further details to follow. Further information will be released, and leaflets will be available from the Sales Centre.

Ecology

- Over 200 new trees are being planted across the site.
- A new sustainable urban drainage pond on the western edge of Chestnuts Field has been constructed, creating a new wetland habitat for wildlife.

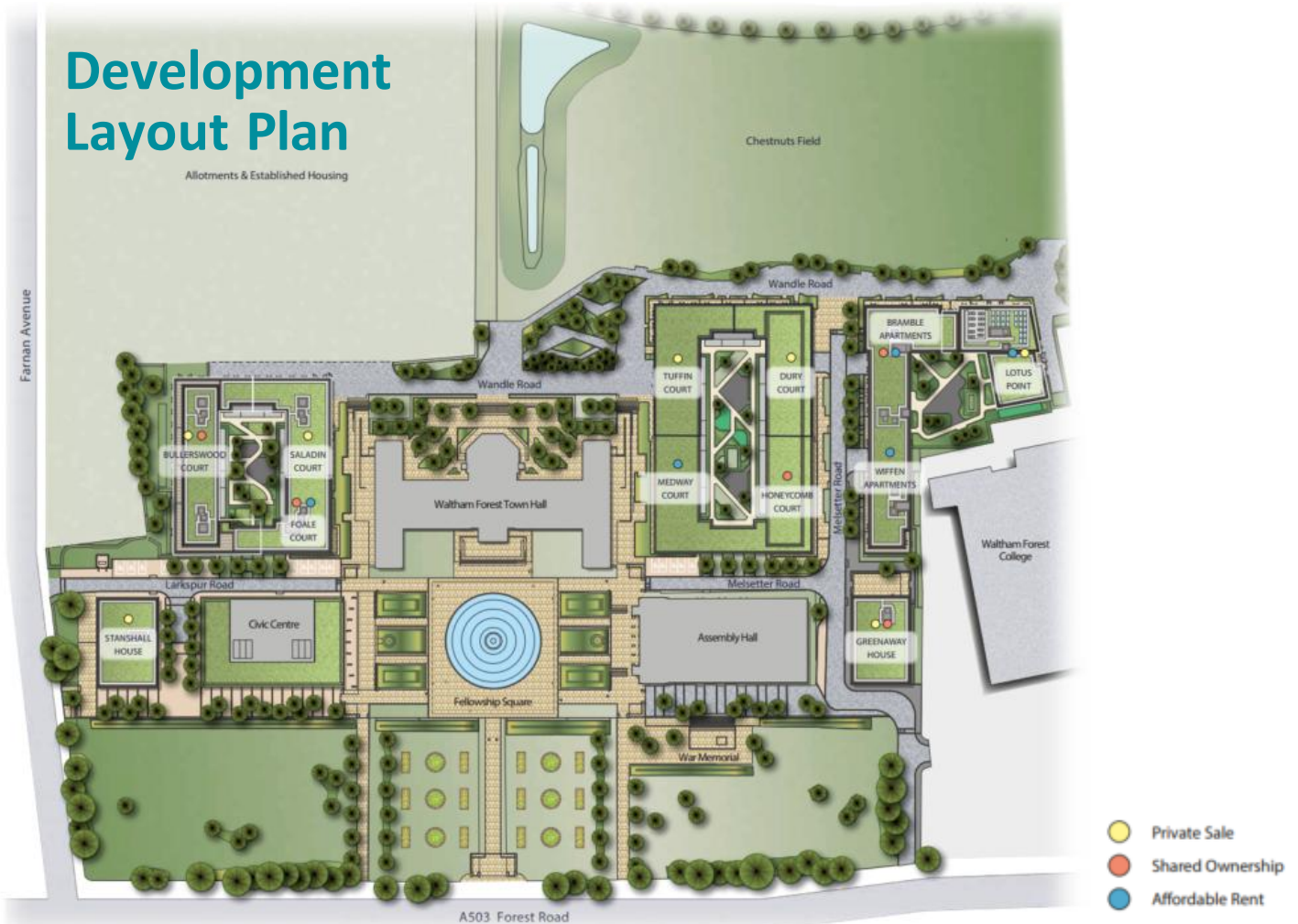


Surrounding Area

Walthamstow Assembly Hall is expected to reopen in late 2026. The Assembly Hall provides a valuable community space for weddings, activities and cultural events. The building is designed to act as a hub for this thriving new community and has been open since the 1960's previously hosting events from the Rolling Stones, The Royal Philharmonic Orchestra & various other theatre & comedy shows.

How will the development benefit the local community?

Hepworth Place will support the local community by contributing over £3,000,000 towards:

- S106 contributions including construction apprentices, work experience and supporting local people into job vacancies on site.
- Civic Fund to support local initiatives and delivering £18m in social value.
- One local initiative the Civic Fund is supporting is Waltham Forests Door to Shop Shopping Service where elderly or disabled residents of Waltham Forest can pay £4 for a return trip to the supermarket from/to their door. Volunteer support is provided to those requiring help in the supermarket with selecting products and pushing trolleys.
