# Keeping you updated

We wanted to provide you with an update on the development and what you can expect from us over the coming months.

#### **Overview**

- The Allium Park phase I development will deliver 220 new homes. 47 of these homes will be private homes (including custom build) and I72 will be mixed tenure/affordable homes.
- The development will benefit from extensive areas of public open space and a designated play area.
- Surface water drainage will be managed by a sustainable urban drainage system (SUDs).
- EV charging and PV panels will be provided to a number of homes to improve energy efficiency across the development.

### Site activity

- Homes across the site are currently at a range of build stages from foundations through to second fix.
- Works have commenced on the S278 to the northern roundabout and are progressing.
- On site S38 works are progressing.

#### **Timeline**

- The show home and marketing suite is progressing well with an anticipated launch due Winter 2026.
- The first release of new homes took place in February. Please check the website for full details.
- The local equipped area of play (LEAP) is anticipated to be opened by the 100th occupation on the development.



# Managing agent

- Vistry have appointed RMG as the Managing Agent for the development. They will look after the private roads and footpaths, as well as landscaping.
- Handovers to the management company will be staggered as and when each of the areas are completed.

# Ecology

- We will be installing a range of Ecological enhancements across the development including the planting of numerous new trees and plants, as well as initiatives such as hedgehog highways which are designed to allow hedgehogs to travel through gaps in fences through the site.
- We are also carrying out a programme of installation of bird and bat boxes throughout the development.
- A number of insect hibernacula's will also be provided to further enhance ecology.



## **Services**

All of our homes on the development are served by mains gas, electricity, water and telecommunications and broadband.
