Keeping you updated

We wanted to provide you with an update on the development and what you can expect from us over the coming months.

Overview

Summary of what's being built:

- A mixed tenure of 178 homes in production.
- A tenure of 51 affordable units, 66 PRS units and 61 private units.
- 2 traditional blocks and 1 timber frame block
- 1 LEAP play area in the northern section of the development
- 1 attenuation basin to the north

Site activity

- Block 9 external masonry envelope is in progress in conjunction with internal first fixing works
- Timber frame plots continue to be delivered and erected on a weekly basis
- Decorations on our first group of PRS and HA plots have commenced

Specific item -

• The EBLR road to be opened in March allowing site construction access to enter from the north of the deployment

Timeline

- Important dates:
- First Occupations on Phase 2 anticipated Q4 2025
- Show home date and marketing suite launching 5th April

Managing agent

- Firstport will be the managing agent responsible for the upkeep of the development.
- Phase 1 handed over
- Phase 2 & 3 to be handed over TBC

Ecology

- Aspect Ecology have produced an ecological plan comprising of:
- Swift bricks will be installed in plots to the north of the development encouraging nesting
- Hedgehog highways will be formed promoting hedgehog movements



Services
