We wanted to provide you with an update on the development, Bella Wood View and what you can expect from us over the coming months.

#### Overview

The development will include:

- 116 new homes including 90 open market homes and 26 affordable units
- EV charging points to all homes
- Private parking to all homes
- 10 different styles of homes

#### Site activity

- All homes are now built complete on site
- Landscaping is 90% complete on site

#### **Services**

• All services are installed and complete

#### **Ecology**

- 97 trees planted with 13 different species
- 43 different species of shrubs, hedges & herbaceous planted on site
- 6 integral bat boxes
- 3 tree-mounted bird boxes
- 3 dead wood habitat piles
- 6 integral sparrow terrace

## How will the development benefit the local community?

Bella Wood View will also support the local community by contributing over £1,027,961.04 towards:

- Educational contributions £813,447.34
- Greenspace contribution £214,513.70
- We have also supported the local Parish Church of Ss John and Mary Magdalene with their involvement in the Queen's Green Canopy project
